

- CIMET APPLICATION GUIDELINES -

1. All applications to the CIMET Course and Scholarships (students, scholars, EU, Non- EU) must be completed, before the applicable deadline and via our online admission platform available from our website or directly on <http://labh-curien.univ-st-etienne.fr/MasterCimet/neu/app/index.php>
2. Each applicant will have to create one account on our server in order to apply to the Master CIMET.
3. All online application files must be completed with all requested document in order to be evaluated by the selection committee.
4. All correspondence with the coordinating institution **must make reference to your individual four digit file number** available from the PDF format of your application form.
5. All candidates will automatically be considered for the Consortium scholarship applicable to their situation (EU or Non-EU) after applying for the Erasmus Mundus Scholarship. There is **no need to reapply**.
6. The **paper application is no longer requested** in the application phase but will be requested prior to admission **to all selected students**. The selection will be based on the collegial assessment of the full online application by the CIMET selection committee. Before admission, all documents sent by the selected applicants will be verified and checked.
7. The selection criteria are as follows:
  - a. recognition of home institution
  - b. recognized first degree
  - c. adequate academic program
  - d. rank/grade/distinction
  - e. letters of recommendation
  - f. level of language skill
  - g. personal motivation + student plan
  - h. work experience + former international mobility
8. The decisions of the selection committee result in four different outcomes communicated at different dates depending on the deadline for application of each scholarship:
  - A. Selected under the Erasmus Mundus Main list (general category and specific window). (Admission to programme + EM scholarship: January for Non-EU and May for EU students).
  - B. Selected under the Erasmus Mundus Reserve list (general category and specific window) and automatically considered for the Consortium scholarship. (Admission granted and on a reserve list for EM scholarship; February: Non EU; May: EU)
  - C. Selected for the Consortium scholarship (6 scholarships available in each category; EU Non- EU) (Admission + Tuition Fees reduced by half: April/May)
  - D. Not selected: the CIMET entry requirements were not fulfilled (January or April/May)

Note that for the Erasmus Mundus Scholarships for EU or non-EU students, the decision will only be definitive after the final validation by the EACEA and you will receive a notification in April/May (Non-EU) or June (EU).
