In the framework of Erasmus Mundus II and starting from the academic year 2010, the EACEA offers new scholarships that is called category B. These scholarships are devoted for European students and also for third country students \*who have stayed for more than 12 months in the EU countries mentioned on the Erasmus Mundus website.

For the academic year 2012/2014 CIMET Masters Course will 5 Erasmus Mundus scholarships of category B students. The selected student, will receive a grant of 10 000€ per year. The application to an Erasmus Mundus scholarship is done through the classical student's application procedure of CIMET.

It should be noted that the Category A scholarships should be considered as "full scholarships" covering all necessary costs of the student during his/her study period in Europe, whereas Category B scholarships are considered as a "financial contribution" to the student's costs.

## LIST OF THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

**The following documents will be required to be uploaded on the application server (available from the CIMET website) and only selected students will have to post the original version to the coordination office:**

1. The completed application form on the common online server (which will give a username and password to each applicant). Each student participating in the Joint Masters Courses must select among different curricula, corresponding to different specializations. Each curriculum defines the two institutions that the student will visit during the Master Program. Hence the applicant must express preferences on the curriculum, ranking the University of Specialization.
2. A Curriculum Vitae (written in English) stating the main personal information (birth name, birth date, citizenship, address, ...) the studies since high school (degrees, institutions, grades) as well as any professional experience and any other relevant information.
3. A personal motivation statement, written in English, describing the reasons for application to the Master CIMET. The statement must also indicate your preference among the two universities proposed for the first semester, your preference among the two universities proposed for the second semester (i.e. for the first specialization), your preferences among the courses proposed for the second semester and your preference among the two specializations proposed for the third semester (i.e. for the second specialization).
4. Copies of transcripts or other academic records that give proof on the undergraduate and first graduate studies, including credits and grades achieved in each single subject. Documents from outside the consortium countries must be either in English or in original language accompanied by a certified English translation. Depending on the home countries, applicants may be asked to provide Certificates of Authenticity issued by recognized diplomatic or administrative authorities, and to send them by regular mail.
5. Two letters of recommendation (written in English). If it is not common practice in your country to be able to open the recommendation letters, either ask your referees to send them directly to [master.cimet@univ-st-etienne.fr](mailto:master.cimet@univ-st-etienne.fr) and if not possible, do give us the details of your referees whilst we are waiting for the letters by post.
6. A certificate of language proficiency in English or a letter from your University certifying that English was the medium on teaching and learning during your University degree.
7. Research project and publications, if they are mentioned in the Vitae.
8. A copy of your valid passport (validity should be extended to at least six months after the end of the two-year Master programme)
9. An extract of your birth certificate translated in English (if not in one of the language of the consortium).

**Note: The online server will allocate you with a 4 digits file number which should be used in all your correspondence.**

Candidates will be selected by the Joint Graduate Committee of the CIMET consortium. Most of the communication will be performed online through the common platform and via email. The final decision will be notified approximately three weeks after the applicable deadline.
